

TITLE IX BUSINESS REGULATIONS

9.01 ORDINANCE REQUIRING LICENSE FOR PEDDLERS & SOLICITORS
(Ordinance 4, Series 1954)

SECTION 1. LICENSE REQUIRED

Every person engaged in peddling goods, wares, or any merchandise of any kind in the City, or soliciting for any purpose shall pay a monthly license fee of ten dollars (\$10). No such license shall give authority for more than one natural person to solicit or peddle within the City Limits, nor shall any person to whom a license is granted sell or solicit by agents or employees or in any other way than by himself in person, and each agent or employee shall procure a separate license. Such license shall be obtained from the City clerk and each licensee, while engaged in his business, shall carry his license and exhibit the same whenever required to do so by an official of this City.

SECTION 2. PENALTY

Any Person who shall violate the provisions of this ordinance shall be, upon conviction, subject to a fine or penalty of One Hundred Dollars (\$100) and costs for each offense.

9.02 AN ORDINANCE LIMITING HOME-BUSINESS ACTIVITY WITHIN THE CITY OF BEECHWOOD VILLAGE
(Ordinance No. 3, Series 1995)

SECTION 1. LIMITATIONS

Upon and following the adoption and publication of this Ordinance, persons choosing to operate Businesses within the City of Beechwood Village are now subject to the following limitations:

- A) Home-Businesses may not employ any person who does not live in the home;
- B) Home-businesses may not offer any merchandise for retail sale;
- C) No more than ten (10) percent of the living space within the residence may be utilized by home-business;
- D) Home-businesses may not use outside advertising visible on or through the exterior of the home/property to the extent that signage would be incompatible with existing restrictions of record in Ordinances Nos. 7 & 8, Series 1992;
- E) No mechanical equipment besides that which is normally used at a residence may be utilized by home-businesses;
- F) No parking space other than the driveway of the home may be used by customers of home businesses;

- G) Hours of operation, where customers require ingress and egress, are limited from 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.
- H) No business may create any hazardous traffic condition.

SECTION 2. REGISTRATION

All home-business must register as such by submitting a statement describing the type of business to be operated, location and name of proprietor of the Beechwood Village City Clerk.

SECTION 3. PENALTY

Failure to register as required by and as set out in Section 2 of this ordinance shall result in a fine of not more than \$25 nor more than \$100.
