**Waste Management Contract Renewal**

In Beechwood Village, we enjoy a high level of service from our waste collection contractor. Waste Management does not require that trash totes be placed at the curb on trash pick-up days, and most large trash items are picked up on the weekly runs. So, we are very pleased to report that Waste Management has agreed to extend our current contract through June 30, 2023, with NO price increase! That will help to keep our city expenses down, and save taxpayer dollars.

**City Tax Ordinance  
Garbage Assessment, 2018 Budget**

The City will not be changing the tax assessments for our new fiscal year starting July 1, 2017. All City business will be handled based on the approved budget, and the City will maintain capital accounts in order to prepare for future road paving.

**BMW Dealership Opens**

BMW of Louisville has opened its newly-renovated Certified Pre-Owned dealership at 4311 Shelbyville Road. That property is located in St. Matthews.

The BMW dealership has also filed for rezoning approval to expand its facility by purchasing the adjacent property at 100 and 102 Marshall Drive in Beechwood Village. The existing apartment buildings would be demolished, and replaced by auto parking and display space for the dealership.

Beechwood Village city government has worked with the BMW dealership to address drainage, lighting, noise, and aesthetic issues to ensure the proposed expansion would enhance the quality of life for our Beechwood Village residents.

Final action on the rezoning proposal is still pending before Metro Government.

**A FACELIFT FOR BLENHEIM**

Blenheim Road is one of the busiest streets in Beechwood Village. That means it also gets a lot of wear and tear. To keep traffic moving smoothly, the BWV City Council has authorized a repaving project for Blenheim.

Repaving can cause temporary inconvenience, but good quality streets are an important long-term asset for our community.

In order to effectively enforce our parking regulations (particularly for repeat offenders), Kentucky law establishes an appeal process for parking violations (KRS 82.620).

We are seeking a dedicated, community-minded neighbor to attend the meetings of the Code Enforcement Review Board in Graymoor-Devondale, when we have BWV parking violation appeals on the agenda.

You must be a fulltime Beechwood Village resident. The time commitment is expected to be minimal, and a small stipend is offered for each meeting the BWV representative is required to attend. 

**SECTION 7.** This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.



ORDINANCE No. 2 , Series 2017

**AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE LEVY OF AD VALOREM  
TAXES FOR THE CITY PURPOSES AND GARBAGE COLLECTION  
ASSESSMENT FOR FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2018**

Whereas by Ordinance No. 8 Series 1970, the City of Beechwood Village elected to use the annual county assessment for properties situated in the City of Beechwood Village, and

Whereas, there has been deposited with the City Clerk-Treasurer, a complete list of all taxable property located in the City as of January 1, 2017

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF BEECHWOOD VILLAGE:**

**SECTION 1.** The tax rate for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018 is hereby levied and fixed at the rate of \$0.13 per \$100.00 of property as assessed for taxation.

**SECTION 2.** The City Clerk-Treasurer shall cause to be made out and mailed assessment rolls on or before August 15, 2017. Each bill shall identify each lot and assessment separately, the names of the owners, the tax rate, total tax due, annual garbage collection assessment, if applicable, and the total of the bill.

**SECTION 3.** The payment of tax bills shall be made to the City Clerk-Treasurer and shall be subject to the discounts and penalties listed below and the collection remedies provided by law.

- A. A Discount of 2% shall be allowed on tax bills paid during August, 2017
- B. The face amount of the tax bill shall be payable during September, 2017
- C. On tax bills paid during October, 2017, there shall be added thereto a penalty of 10% of the tax due. On tax bills paid after October 31, 2017 there shall be added interest 1 ½% per month or part thereof, compounded monthly, or \$10.00 if the penalty and interest is less than that amount, plus lien filing and release fees, if applicable, and also collection expenses, including but not limited to reasonable attorney fees

**SECTION 4.** The proceeds of such taxes shall be used for the general operating expenses of the City, including the purchasing of city supplies, the erection of city signs, the general maintenance of public ways in the city, payment of bond premiums for city officials, sanitation, public safety and payment of all the expenses incurred in the necessary and proper municipal functions.

**SECTION 5.** The annual budget garbage collection assessment for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018 is hereby levied and fixed at \$132.00 per each residence and per dwelling unit in each multiple family building in the city. Such assessment shall be due on or before August 31, 2017

# Metro Government Challenges Garbage Collection Law

Earlier this year, the Kentucky General Assembly passed and the Governor signed House Bill #246. Among other things, this new law guarantees the right of small cities in Jefferson County to make their own decisions regarding garbage collection and solid waste management.

Louisville Metro Government has objected to this new Kentucky law, and is seeking to overturn it. Metro has filed a lawsuit against both the state and the small cities of Jefferson County, including Beechwood Village.

At stake is the ability of Beechwood Village to decide for itself the best and most cost-effective policies for our residents and taxpayers. The alternative would be one-size-fits-all decisions for the entire county, which could diminish our familiar high quality of services and increase our costs. As a defendant in this lawsuit, Beechwood Village is joining with other small cities to preserve local decision-making, and let each community have its own say. ## PARK LEGALLY AND AVOID A TICKET

We're proud of our community spirit in Beechwood Village. One of the ways you can support our community is to observe our local parking regulations.

Some of the most frequent parking violations are:

**OVERNIGHT PARKING** - Parking is not allowed on city streets between the hours of 2AM and 6AM, seven days a week.

**PARKING OPPOSITE ANOTHER VEHICLE** - It is illegal to park opposite another parked vehicle on the other side of the street. Our streets are narrow, and illegally parked cars can prevent fire trucks, ambulances, and other emergency vehicles from getting through.

**YARD PARKING** - Parking is allowed only in garages, driveways, and on the street. For on-street parking, all four wheels must be on the pavement.

**INTERSECTIONS** - No parking is allowed within 30 feet of an intersection or Stop Sign.

**TRAILERS, BOATS, AND RV's** - On-street parking is illegal for buses, utility trailers, boats, and recreational vehicles.

**DESIGNATED NO PARKING ZONES** - There are specially-posted No Parking zones on sections of the following streets: Bramton, Sage, Marshall, Cordova, Biltmore, and Brunswick.


